International connectivity and transportation hubs in Berlin

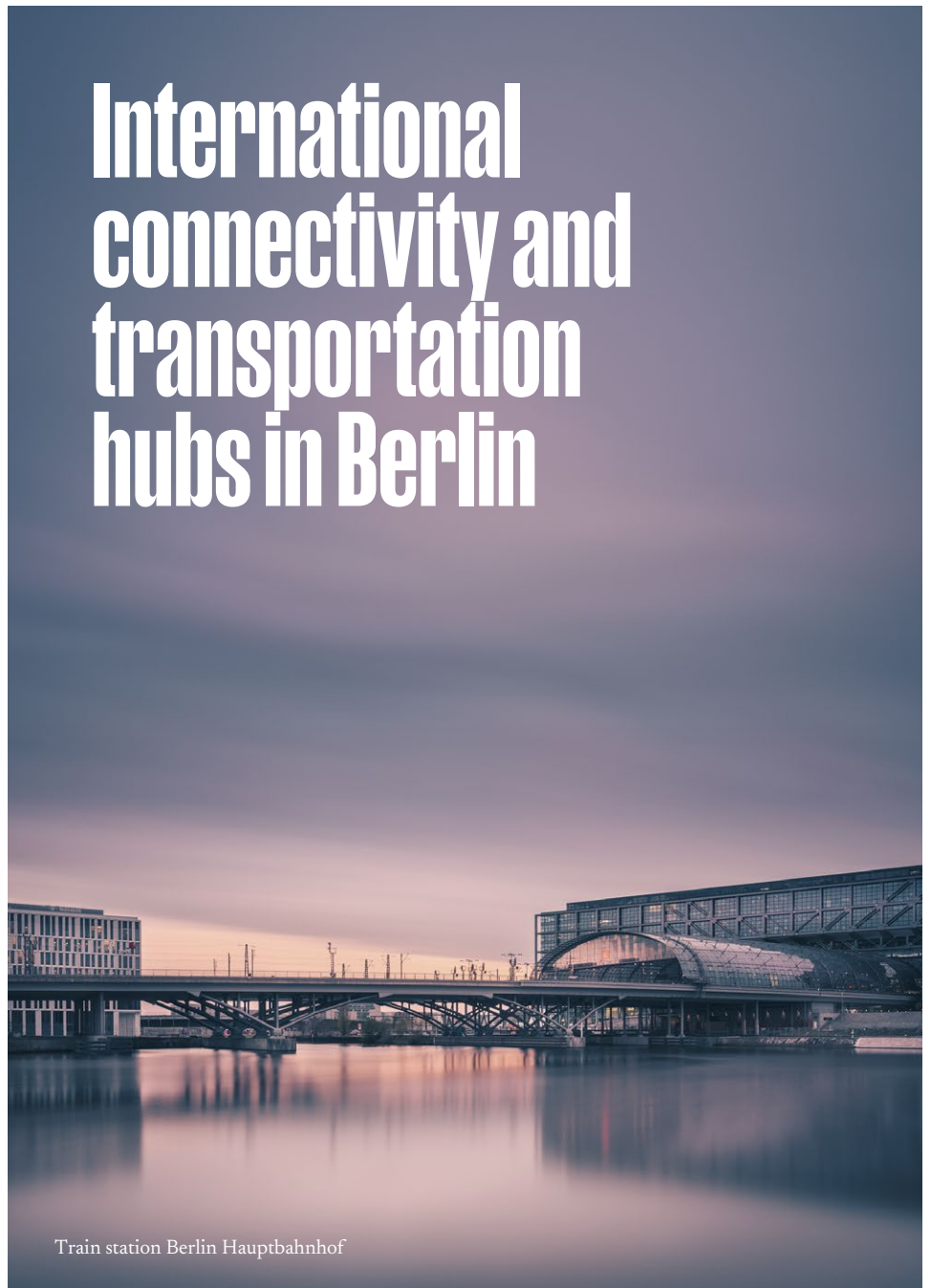

Essential information



Tips when visiting Berlin

- Shops in the centre usually open every day from 9:00 am – 8:00 pm.
- The standard voltage is 220v and the power plug is type F with 2 round pins.
- Berlin has some of the best tap water in the world and is perfectly safe to drink.
- The weather is very pleasant in spring with temperatures between 15 and 25 °C, and the best time to visit is May to September. Autumn brings vibrant colours, as well as cultural events like Berlin Art Week and the Festival of Lights. Berlin has cold winters.
- EU nationals can stay for up to 90 days for certain purposes. A valid passport or visa may be required at border control for some nationalities.

Mobility

Public transport

Bus: Buses connect parts of Berlin not reached by the U-Bahn and S-Bahn. The West has more buses, but traffic can be heavy.

Metro: The subway or U-Bahn has 10 lines with distinctive yellow trains that run 4:00 am – 1:00 am.

Airport Transfers: Travelling to and from BER Airport is fast and efficient. The railway station is at Terminal 1 on level U2 and local bus lines A 1-8 run also from Terminal 1.

Trains: S-Bahn trains are red and yellow and travel everywhere in Berlin and some parts of Brandenburg. The lines begin with an S (S1, S2...). East Berlin is served by a network of trams that begin with the letter M (M2, M2...).

Transport rental

Driving around: Travel to Berlin by car is easy with excellent connections to Germany's transport network. The Berliner Ring (A10) means you can usually get to the centre without traffic jams. The Umweltzone in the Berlin city centre requires environmental emissions sticker to be displayed.

Parking: There are many free parking spaces in Berlin, even in the city centre, making it convenient and handy. Paid parking is from Monday – Saturday, 9:00 am – 10:00 pm.

Renting Bikes: Cycling in Berlin is fun with many companies like Donkey Republic, Call a Bike and Jump offering automated self-service with drop-off docking stations all over the city.

Car Sharing: Download car sharing apps like ShareNow, WeShare or Cambio offering free floating and station based services where cars are located via GPS using the app.

Private driver

Taxis: Around 5,500 taxis are quick and handy and can be hailed on the street when the taxi sign on the roof is illuminated. Taxi stops are also available throughout the city.

Rideshare: Uber, Lyft, Didi, Ola and other apps are available in Berlin.

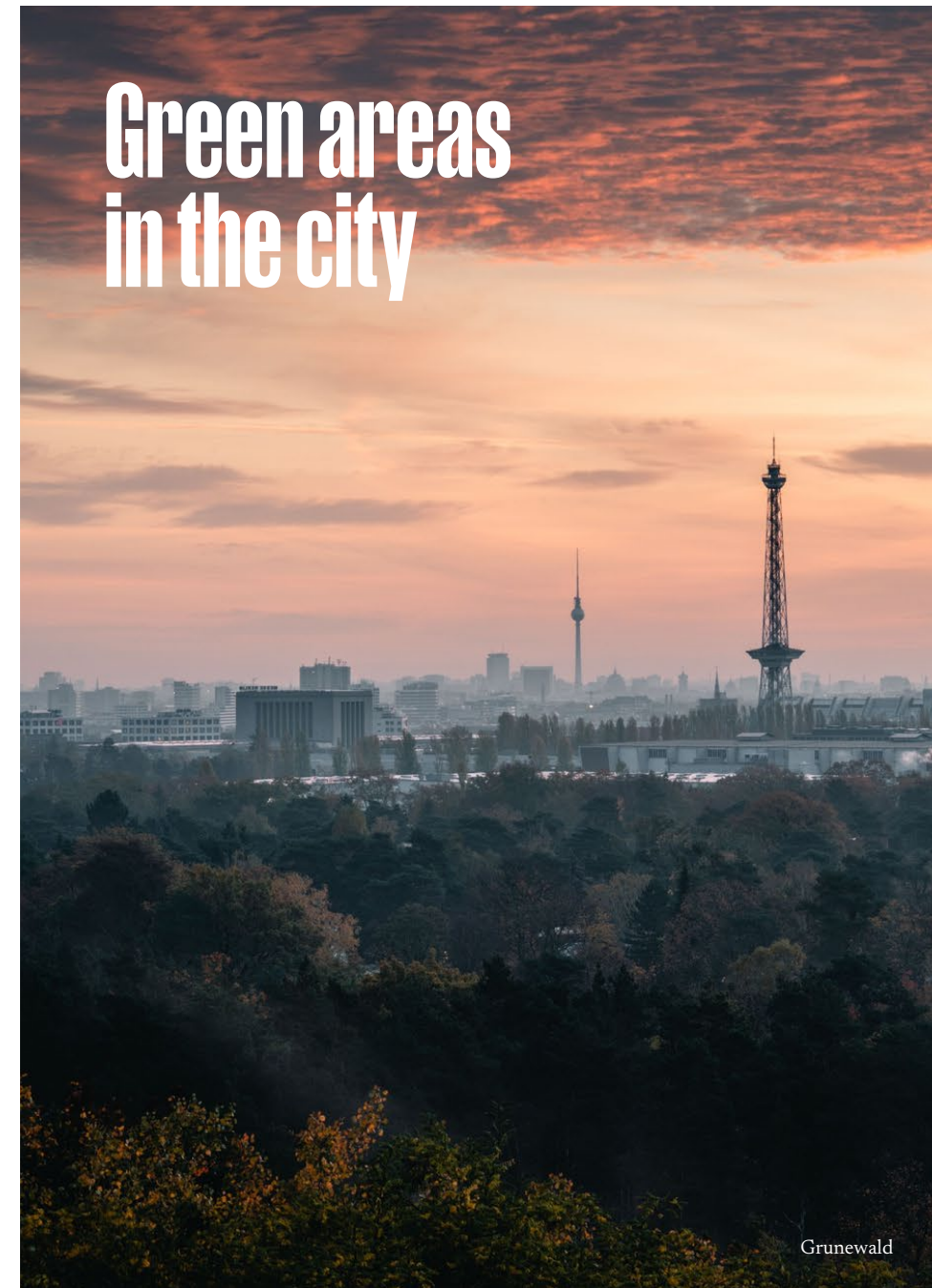
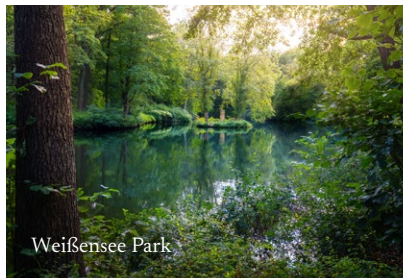
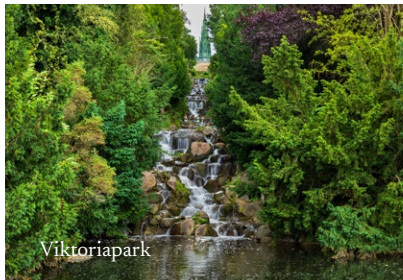
Health

EU citizens can access medical care but we advise you to apply for a European Health Insurance Card.

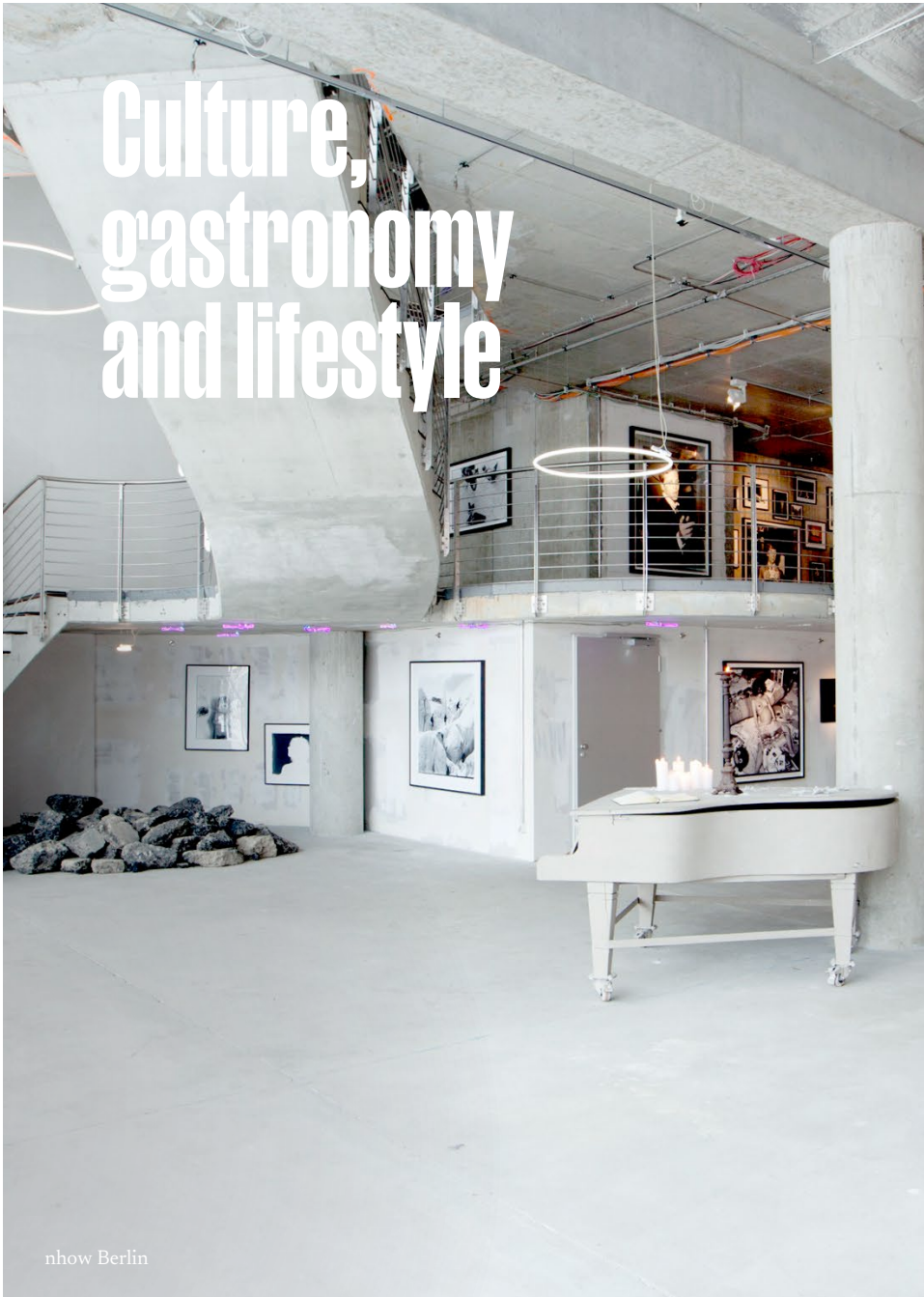
112 is the emergency services (ambulance, fire and rescue) free-phone 24/7 across the EU and covers 80 languages.

Healthcare centres provide primary care while specialist services are available in hospitals. Medicines must be bought in pharmacies displaying the illuminated red "A" with a bowl and snake. Antibiotics are sold on prescription only.

Berlin has plenty of green spaces such as the Tiergarten or the Südgelände, and features smaller more secluded parks and gardens dotted around the city where you can relax and recharge your batteries. Tempelhofer Feld, once an airport, is now a park with wide paths that are perfect for cycling, jogging and skating.

Berlin State Opera

Art & Culture

Brandenburg Gate. Berlin's iconic and only surviving historical gate faces one of the city's most beautiful squares, the Pariser Platz.

Berlin Television Tower. Berlin's most visible iconic landmark stands at 368m located at the Alexanderplatz.

Charlottenburg Palace. Inside you can view the staterooms and the Golden Galerie rococo ballroom, and outside the English-style landscaped Palace Park.

Museum Island. A UNESCO World Heritage Site features 5 large museums, a reception and the exhibition building; the James Simon Gallery.

East Side Gallery. Once the Berlin wall, the East Side Gallery is now a 1.3 km open-air gallery on the banks of the river Spree.

Berlin State Opera. The neo-classical Staatsoper with over 250 years of arts and sciences resembles an ancient temple.

Shopping

Alexa Berlin. Is an art déco shopping mall with over 170 shops situated right on the Alexanderplatz is perfect for fashion, tech, cosmetics and leisure.

Friedrichstrasse. Berlin's main shopping street with 3.5 km of arterial roads where you can stroll and shop and visit Checkpoint Charlie.

Kurfürstendamm. West Berlin's showpiece with luxury labels, culture and world-famous sights. Take a detour down one of the side streets for a spot of lunch.

Hackescher Markt. Popular discotheque area by night and fashionable shopping district by day. The neighbourhood has old-school charm and narrow streets.

Markthalle Neun. A street food market place where people come for good bread, fresh vegetables and many varied dishes.

Arminiusmarkthalle. Elaborate archways, market traders and Austrian farm shops selling schnitzel, Kásspätzle and goulash.

Karl-August-Platz. Weekly market each Wednesday and Saturday where merchants sell arts & crafts, fine wines and antipasti.

Berlin-Kreuzberg. The tastiest döner kebabs in the city, with authentic Turkish cooking and all within walking distance.

Nikolaiviertel. Cafes and restaurants right in the middle of the idyllic Nikolai district with a large selection of places to dine and relax.

Schoenbrunn restaurant. Located in the historic Volkspark features freshly prepared Austrian-Mediterranean cooking.



Special Venues

Treehouse. The Treehouse Berlin is located right in the centre next to the Wall, in the RAW creative district of Friedrichshain.

Spreespeicher. This unique location has views onto the Oberbaumbrücke at Berlin's Eastern Harbour.

Sage Club. Over 3,000 m2 of event space located on the banks of the Spree in Berlin-Kreuzberg.

Magazin in der Heeresbäckerei. Impressive industrial monument with 5m high ceilings and a parquet old beech floor.

Malzfabrik. Variety, charm and ample room with extensive grounds, renovated event spaces and factory floors.

Meistersaal am Potsdamer Platz. Old Berlin charm, sophisticated ambience or trendy lounge, where Bowie, U2 and Depeche Mode made history.

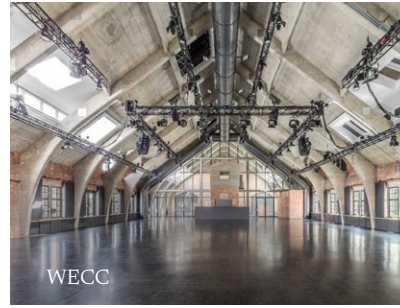
Messe Berlin. CityCube Berlin has over 22,000 m2 of multifunctional event space and capacity for up to 11,000 people.

Hub27. A 10,000m2 open plan multifunctional, column free event area for up to 200 people.

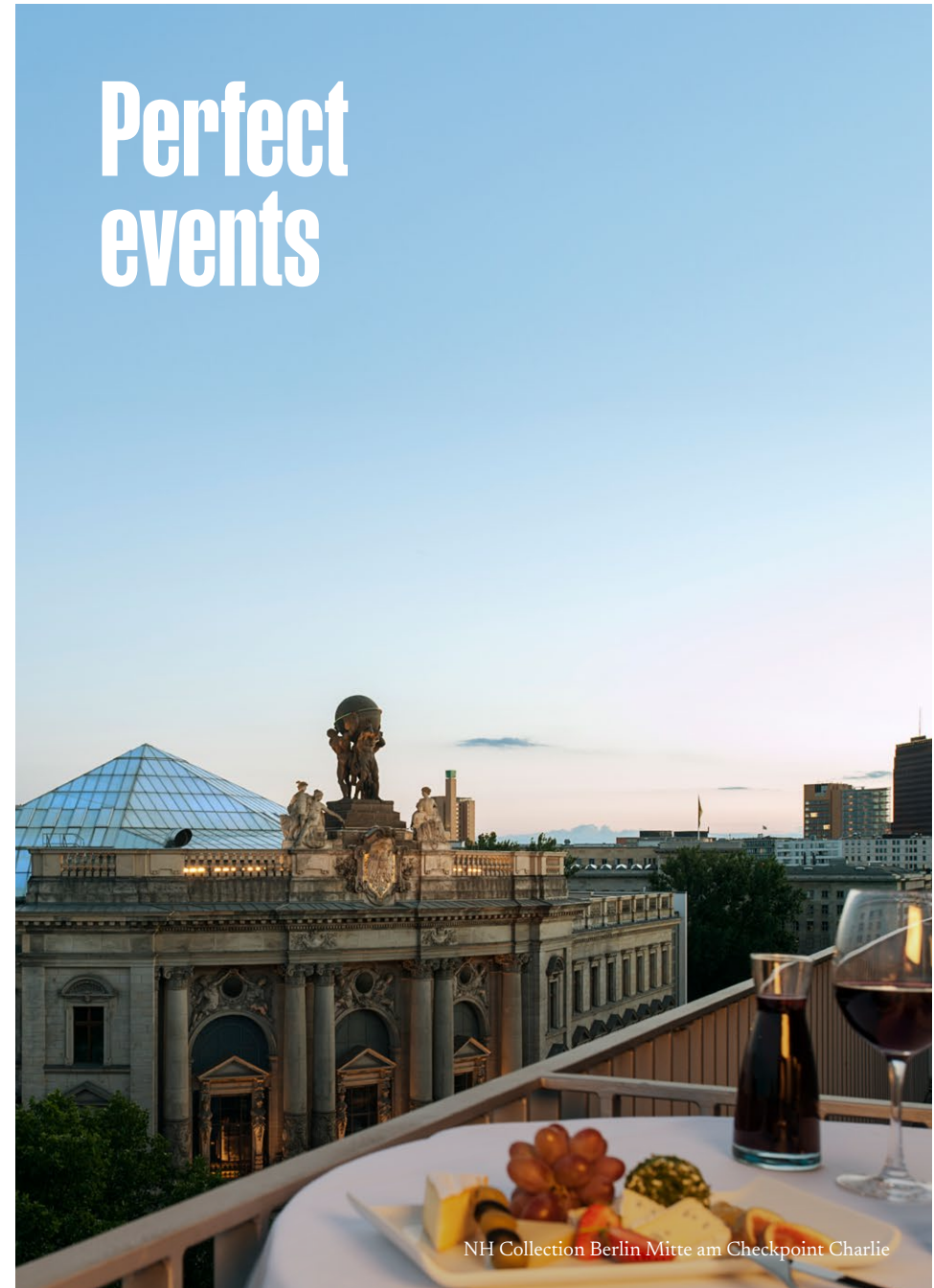
BCC. The Berlin Congress Center spans 5,000 square metres with exceptional design quality and plenty of daylight.

WECC. The Westhaven Event & Conference Center is a state-of-the-art former warehouse with capacity for 1,500 people.



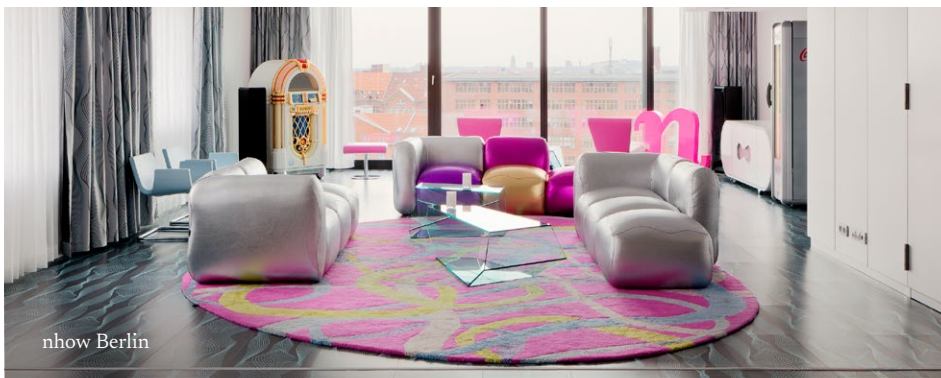

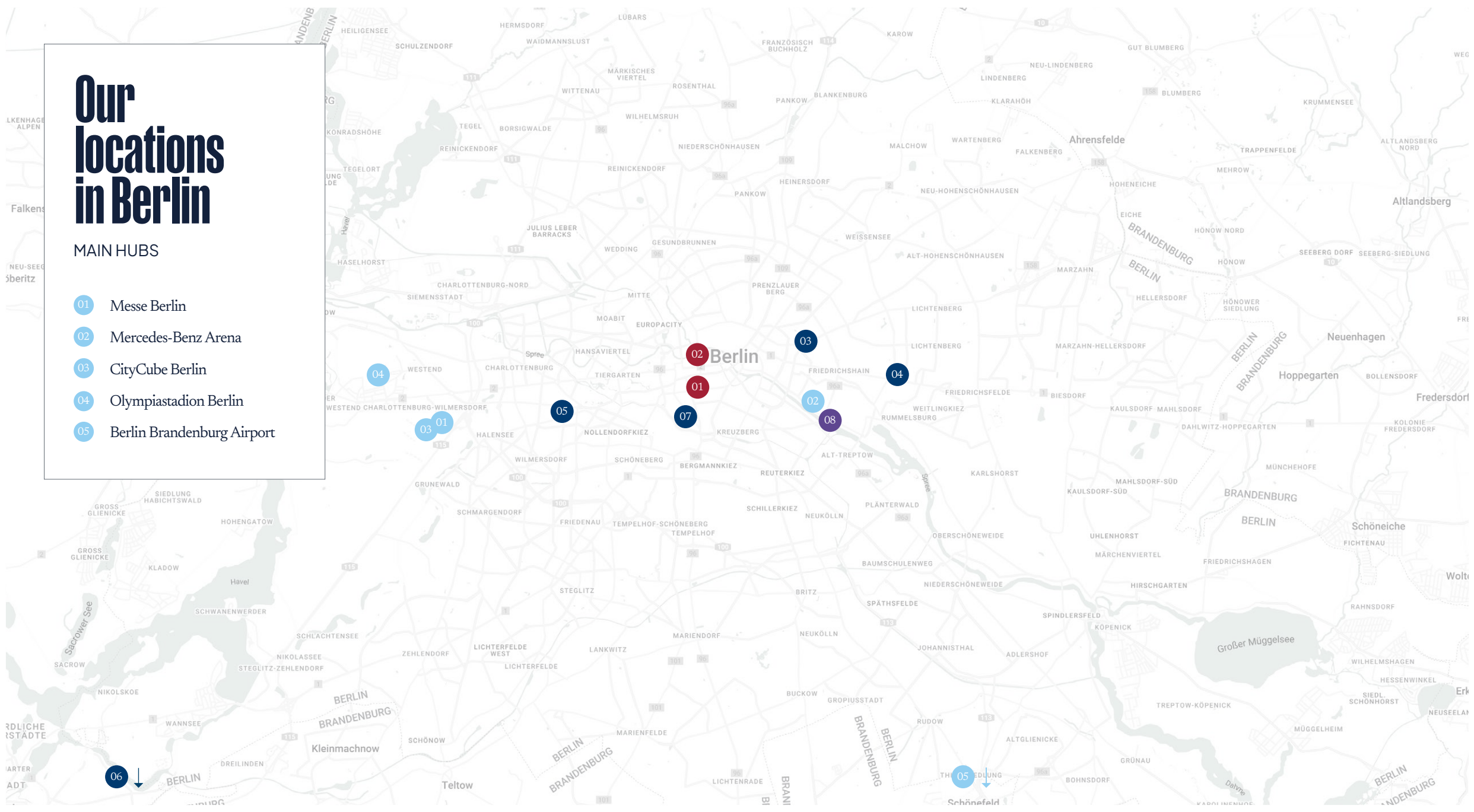

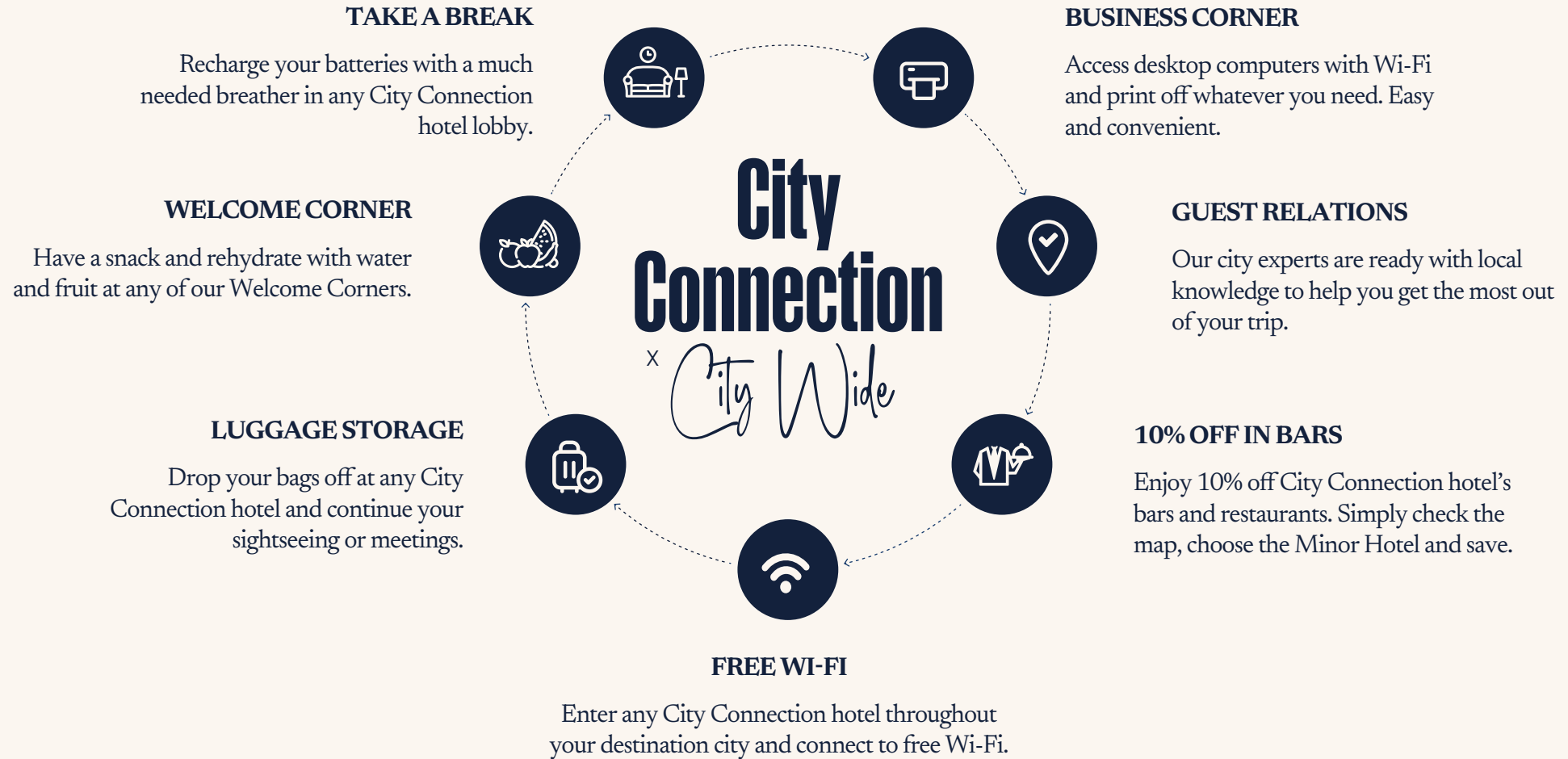

Sustainable Certifications

Minor Europe & America's hotel portfolio is certified, both in environmental impact assessment of the construction and operation of its buildings, as well as in energy efficiency systems for accommodation, services, meetings and events. Responsible Energy Management

We promote an efficient energy management system, defined under ISO 50001 criteria, and prioritise the use of green electricity from renewable sources in all our hotels. 85% of the company's electricity comes from renewable energy sources.



Responsible Water Management

We have implemented water-saving measures such as installing reduction devices in cisterns and innovative water recovery systems. Additionally, we support employee training and awareness initiatives, as well as the redesign of the kitchen and housekeeping operational guidelines to further promote sustainability efforts.

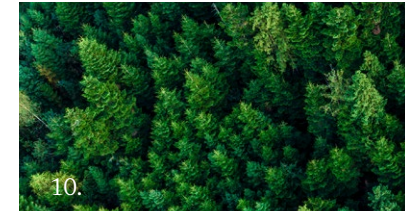
Green Mobility
