Tips when visiting Lisbon

- Most stores in Lisbon are open Monday to Saturday, from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm and from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm.
- The standard voltage is 220v and the power plug is type F with 2 round pins.
- The tap water is safe to drink but smells of chlorine. Locals tend to drink bottled water and use tap water for everything else.
- Summers are balmy with daily averages reaching 27°C. The warm season lasts from June to September. January is coldest at 11°C and July has most sunshine hours. Average sea temperatures in September are 20°C.
- EU nationals can stay for up to 90 days for certain purposes. A valid passport or visa may be required at border control for some nationalities.

Mobility

Public transport

Bus: 172 routes run from 5:00 am to 11:00 pm, then night buses takeover.

Metro: 4 lines, modern and air-conditioned, the fastest way to travel, open from 6:30 am to 1:00 am.

Airport Shuttle: Lisbon airport to city centre (lines 1 & 2) take about 40 mins, with buses every 20 mins.

Ferries: Connecting Lisbon and the Tejo south bank operate every 20 – 30 mins.

Trains: Sintra and Cascais lines run every 15-20 mins. They take about 40 mins and run from 6:00 am to 1:00 am.

Transport rental

Driving around: Can be complicated and stressful due to small streets, one way systems and the rush hour 6-8pm.

Parking: Metres are available throughout the city with zone pricing.

Renting Bikes: With over 40 miles of cycle routes, bike sharing is a great way to explore the city.

Car Sharing: Uber and Bolt offer a quality service, just need to download the app.

Shared Mopeds: Dockless electric scooters are fun and available throughout the city.

Private driver

Taxis: Lisbon taxis are black and green and relatively cheap, most accept cards.

Private Transport with Driver: Chauffeur and limousine services are available.

Health

EU citizens can access medical care but we advise you to apply for a European Health Insurance Card.

112 is the emergency services (ambulance, fire and rescue) free-phone 24/7 across the EU and covers 80 languages.

Healthcare centres provide primary care while specialist services are available in hospitals.

Medicines must be bought in pharmacies displaying the illuminated green cross.

Antibiotics are sold on prescription only.

Lisbon has many enchanting parks and green areas offering a refreshing escape from urban life, like Jardim da Estrela, a charming park located in the Estrela neighbourhood with beautifully landscaped gardens, perfect for leisurely walks or picnics. It's popular with locals, and visitors can enjoy a cup of coffee and homemade desserts.



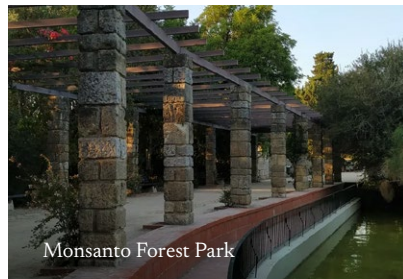

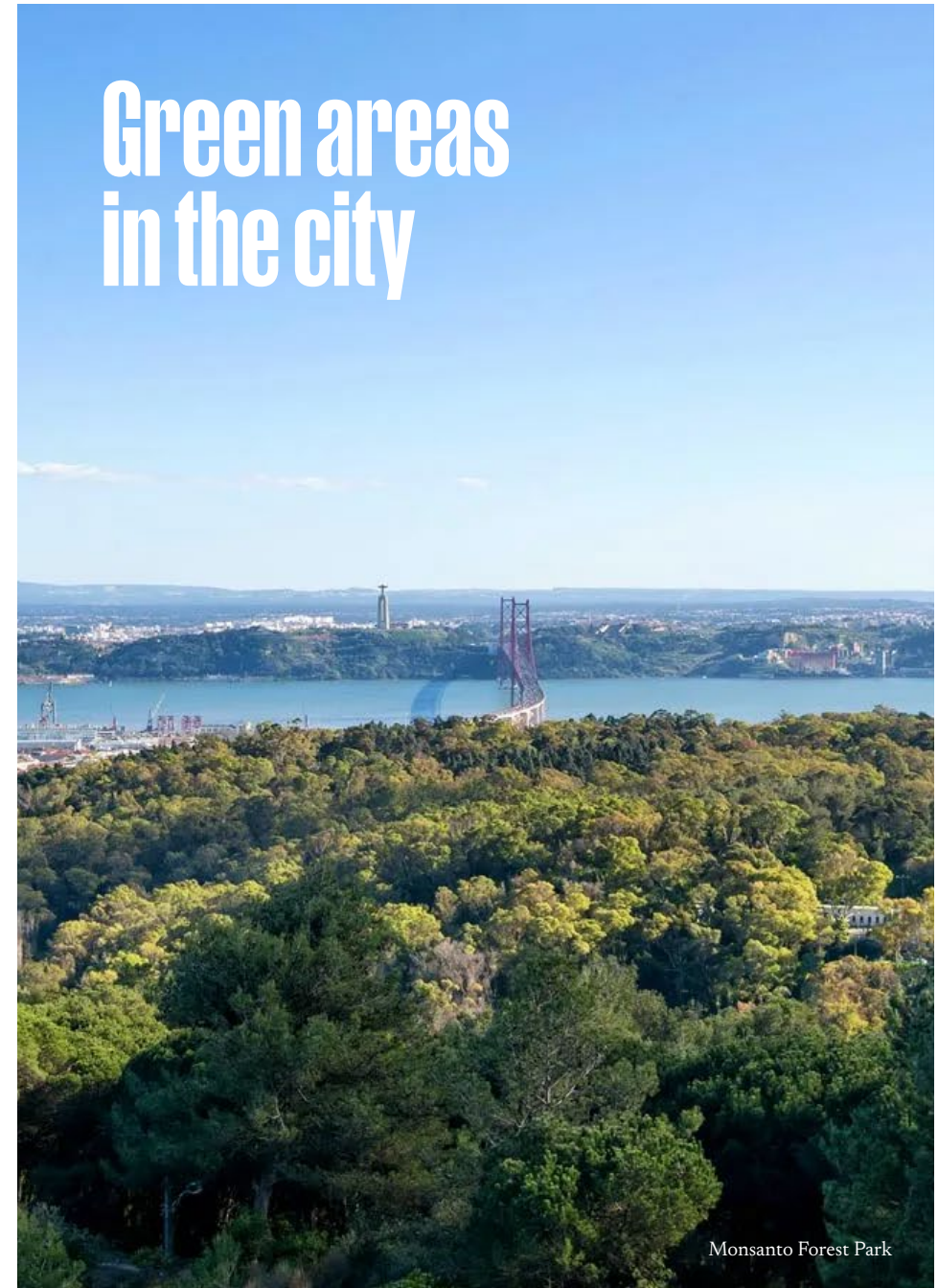

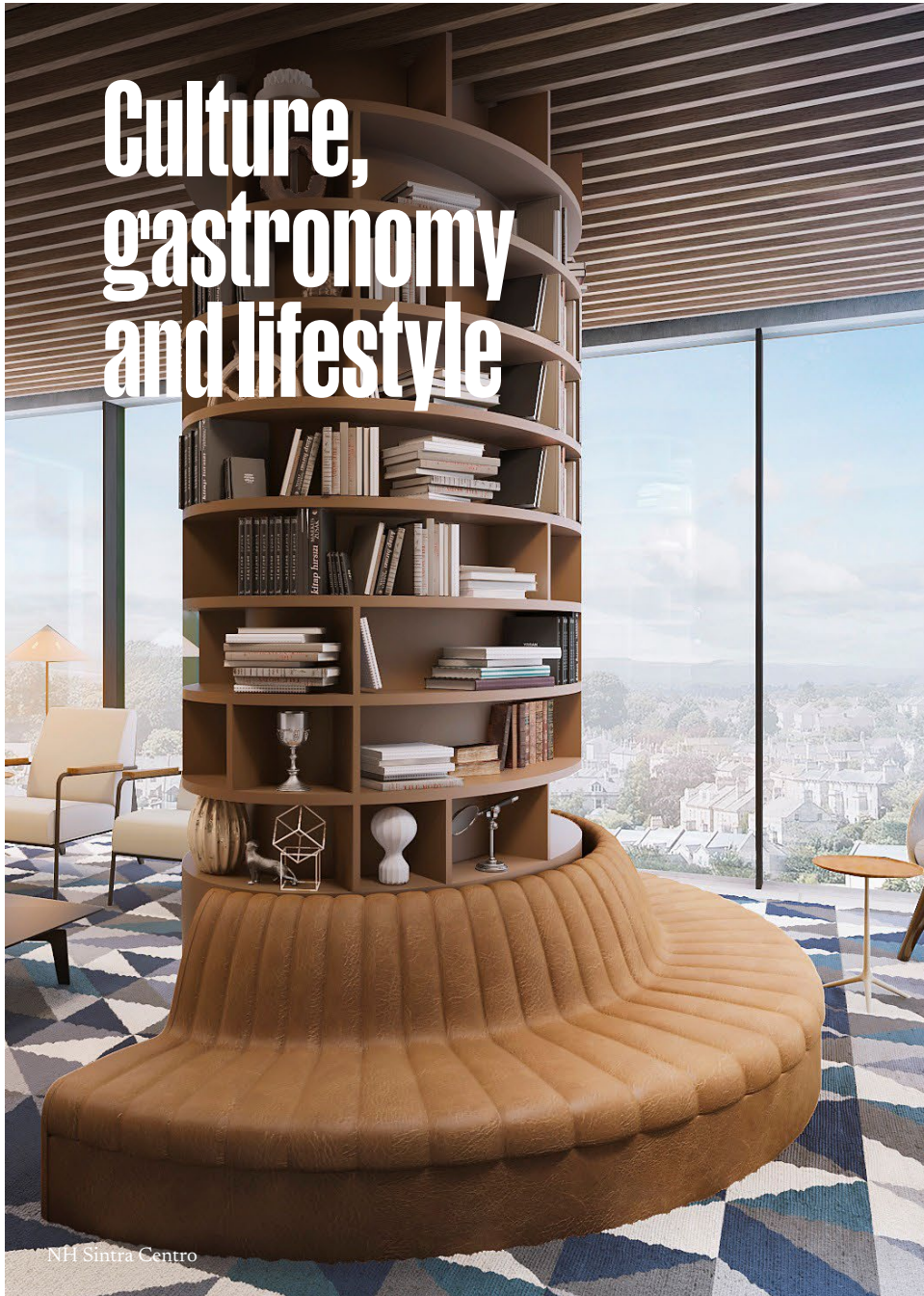

Art & Culture

Praça do Comércio. One of Lisbon's iconic squares right on the waterfront is the perfect starting point for discovering the city.

Quinta da Regaleira. Located near to Sintra, this UNESCO World Heritage Site consists of a Romantic palace and chapel featuring lakes, grottoes and exquisite statues.

Jerónimos Monastery. One of the most important tourist attractions in Lisbon and features the tomb of Vasco de Gama.

Belem Tower. UNESCO World Heritage and one of Lisbon's most important monuments standing as a symbol of maritime discoveries.

National Tile Museum. Founded in 1509 and set in the unique Madre de Deus Convent, and is one of Portugal's most important museums.

Shopping

Rua Garret. One of Lisbon's finest upscale shopping areas dating back to the 1700s with streets of mosaic cobblestones and tiled buildings.

Rua Augusta. Lisbon's liveliest pedestrian street cobbled in traditional Portuguese designs and lined with international brands and age-old shops.

Avenida Liberdade. This is Lisbon's main avenue for luxury shopping mimicking some of Paris's famous chic, a place to see and be seen.

Rua do Carmo. Set in downtown Lisbon, this extremely busy pedestrian street connects Praça do Rossio to Chiado.

Rua da Escola. Antique stores, boutiques and tiny cafes abound with modern stores mixed in, from old postcards to vintage cameras.

Rua do poco dos negros. One of Lisbon's coolest neighbourhoods with theatres, burlesque shows, coffee shops and cosy book stores.

Lisbon's food & drinks scene is diverse, relatively cheap and seemingly endless, from Pastel de Nata to Bitoque – the traditional Portuguese steak dish topped with a fried egg. You can hunt out the local gems and Lisbon restaurants to rediscover what Portuguese food can be, while exploring the massive food halls along the waterfront.

Top 3 recommended restaurants

Nova Wine Bar. Over 600 wines selected from local producers, where the guest chooses the food and they suggest the wine.

Bono Lisboa. A hidden diamond of a restaurant in a beautiful setting and intimate ambience with excellent staff and delicious food.

Re tasco. An exceptional restaurant with exotic dishes of quality food at very affordable prices. Great service and friendly staff.

Convento Beato. A stunning historical venue with space for up to 5,500 people, a reference venue in Lisbon.



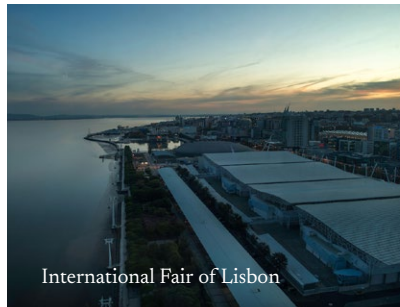
International Fair of Lisbon

Convention Centres

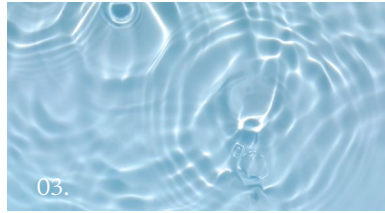
Sustainable Certifications

Minor Europe & America's hotel portfolio is certified, both in environmental impact assessment of the construction and operation of its buildings, as well as in energy efficiency systems for accommodation, services, meetings and events. These include BREEAM, LEED, DGNB, ISO 14001, Green Key, Hoteles Más Verdes, Biosphere and Bioscore.



Responsible Energy Management

We promote an efficient energy management system, defined under ISO 50001 criteria, and prioritise the use of green electricity from renewable sources in all our hotels. 85% of the company's electricity comes from renewable energy sources.



Responsible Water Management

We have implemented water-saving measures such as installing reduction devices in cisterns and innovative water recovery systems. Additionally, we support employee training and awareness initiatives, as well as the redesign of the kitchen and housekeeping operational guidelines to further promote sustainability efforts.



Reducing Single-Use Plastic

We strive to minimise the use of paper and single-use plastics, replacing them with reusable or biodegradable alternatives, when possible, to reduce waste. You'll find returnable glass bottles, biodegradable candy wrappers and pens, which are made from recycled material, in our meeting rooms. 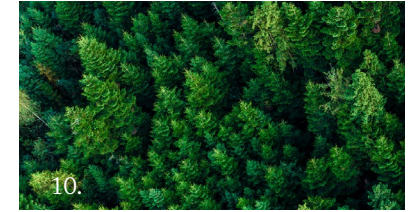
Green Mobility
