Tips when visiting Madrid

- Shops in the centre usually open every day from 9:00 am – 8:00 pm.
- The standard voltage is 220v and the power plug is type F with 2 round pins.
- Water in Madrid is excellent quality and perfectly safe to drink.
- Summers are short, hot, dry and mostly clear. Winters are cold and partly cloudy, rarely below 23°F/-5°C. The best time of the year to visit Madrid with clear rainless days and good temperature is from mid-May to early October, with the peak period in the second week of September.
- EU nationals can stay for up to 90 days for certain purposes. A valid passport or visa may be required at border control for some nationalities.

Mobility

Public transport

Bus: Explore the city sustainably with hybrid and electric buses.

Metro: Fastest way to travel around Madrid and Barajas Airport.

Express Bus to the Airport: It is available 24/7 for 5€, with credit cards accepted.

Train: The Cercanías network is the most affordable way to visit nearby beautiful cities and towns such as Segovia, Aranjuez, Toledo, etc.

Transport rental

Driving around: Follow Spanish traffic regulations and ensure your vehicle has the required ECO emissions sticker.

Parking: Paid and controlled, with limited access in the city centre. However, it's free on Saturdays after 3:00 pm and Sundays all day.

Renting Bikes: There is an expanding network of bike paths and various rental options.

Car Sharing: Companies like Free2Move, Wible, Zity, and Voltio offer car-sharing services in the city.

Shared Motorbikes: Numerous electric motorbikes available via apps.

Private driver

Taxis: The city has over 15,000 taxis available 24/7.

Private Transport with Driver: Apps like Uber, Cabify, and Bolt offer convenient ways to move around Madrid.

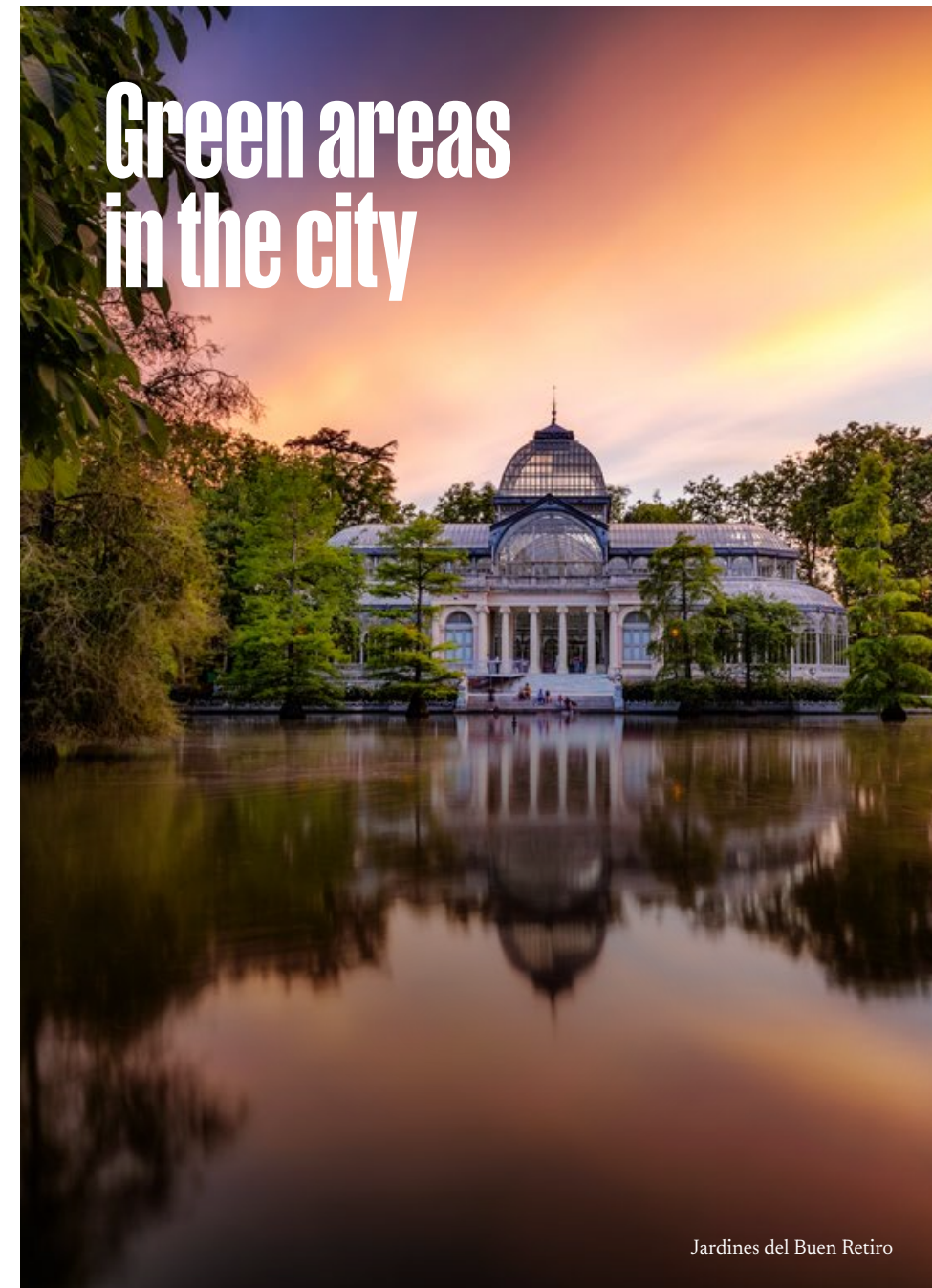
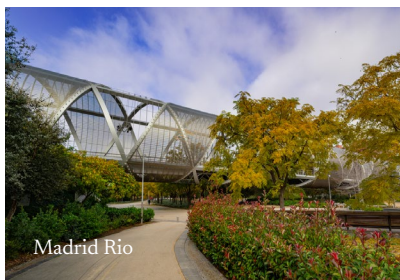
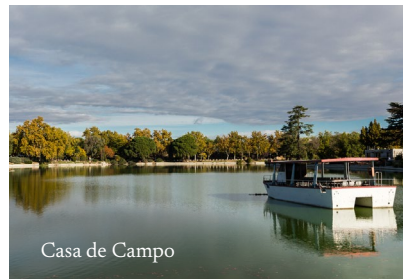
Health

EU citizens can access medical care but we advise you apply for a European Health Insurance Card.

112 is the emergency services (ambulance, fire and rescue) free-phone 24/7 across the EU and covers 80 languages.

Healthcare centres provide primary care while specialist services are available in hospitals. Medicines must be bought in pharmacies displaying the illuminated green cross. Antibiotics are sold on prescription only.

Madrid is full of parks, gardens and green areas where you can stroll, have a coffee or just watch life pass by. El Retiro Park is a UNESCO World Heritage site, right in the heart of the capital, where you can take a break from the busy hustle and bustle of city life. The Casa de Campo is Madrid's largest park and home to the Madrid Zoo and one of its amusement parks. Madrid Río Park runs along the banks of the river Manzanares, where you can spend long afternoons meandering among the many café bars or rent bicycles and cycle the well-planned paths that circle this area.

Gran Vía. The most famous street in Madrid, a central hub alive at anytime of the day or night, with emblematic buildings like the Metropolis and Carrion with its famous Schweppes billboard.

Serrano and Ortega & Gasset. Luxury stores line this fashionable district of the Salamanca quarter. Both streets are lined with impressive residential buildings from the early 20th century.

El Rastro. Madrid's most popular open-air flea market. It is organized in La Latina every Sunday morning and has been the place to go for over 400 years for many curious objects.

Malasaña. Madrid's benchmark for retro fashion and underground culture. It is also closely linked to the Movida, the cultural and social revolution that arose in Madrid during the 1980s.



Tapas Bars & Restaurants

Food & Drink Culture

Tapas bars & restaurants. Cava Baja, Cava Alta and Humilladeros are home to some of the most historic tabernas. Patatas bravas, potato omelette, croquettes, olives, mature cheeses, and offal dishes.

Roof top bars. In recent years Madrid has seen a boom in elevated venues, and you can now find a great rooftop bar in pretty much all corners of the city. Picalagartos and NH Collection Casa Suecia are just two of the best.

Top 3 recommended restaurants

Diverxo (3 Michelin Stars) A cosmopolitan restaurant that offers two spectacular tasting menus, the second of which is almost never-ending.

Deessa (2 Michelin Stars) Celebrity chef Quique Dacosta displays his unique culinary talent at Deessa, the flagship restaurant at the Mandarin Oriental Ritz Hotel, Madrid.

Paco Roncero (2 Michelin Stars) The Madrid-born chef is a benchmark in Spanish avant-garde cuisine, as well as a passionate fan of technological innovation in the kitchen.

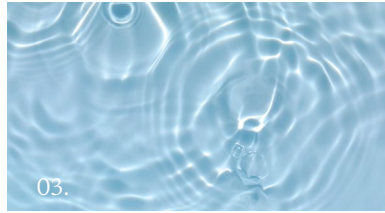
Sustainable Certifications

Minor Europe & America's hotel portfolio is certified, both in environmental impact assessment of the construction and operation of its buildings, as well as in energy efficiency systems for accommodation, services, meetings and events. These include BREEAM, LEED, DGNB, ISO 14001, Green Key, Hoteles Más Verdes, Biosphere and Bioscore.



Responsible Energy Management

We promote an efficient energy management system, defined under ISO 50001 criteria, and prioritise the use of green electricity from renewable sources in all our hotels. 85% of the company's electricity comes from renewable energy sources.



Responsible Water Management

We have implemented water-saving measures such as installing reduction devices in cisterns and innovative water recovery systems. Additionally, we support employee training and awareness initiatives, as well as the redesign of the kitchen and housekeeping operational guidelines to further promote sustainability efforts.

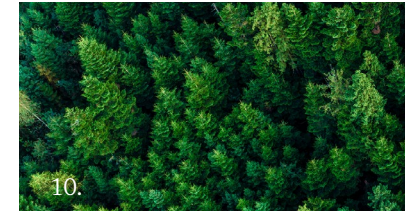
Green Mobility
