# Milan

## Tips when visiting Milan

- Most shops in Milan open every day from 10:00 am – 8:00 pm.
- The standard voltage is 220v and the power plug is type F with 2 round pins.
- Water in Milan is perfectly safe to drink.
- Summers are warm and humid, winters are very cold, and it is partly cloudy all year round. Temperatures vary from 31F(-5C) to 85F (29.5C). The best time to visit is during the spring (March – May) and in autumn (September – November).
- EU nationals can stay for up to 90 days for certain purposes. A valid passport or visa may be required at border control for some nationalities.

## Mobility

### Public transport

**Bus:** Over 80 local bus lines and is one of the best ways to get around the city.

**Metro:** Italy's largest network, spanning 63 miles, has only 5 lines but is one of the most modern in Europe.

**Tram:** Since 1876, trams run until way past midnight, with 18 lines and are numbered from 1 to 33.

**Train:** The Malpensa Express runs from Milan's main airport to Cadorna central station, tickets cost around €11 and takes 40 minutes.

### Transport rental

**Driving around:** A car is not a necessity for getting around Milan. ZTL zones limit access and are equipped with cameras. Entrance is free only for electric vehicles and mopeds.

**Parking:** Intricate and complex and we recommend pre-booking at parking lots.

**Renting Bikes:** Milan is a walkable city, with a robust public bike-sharing system offering affordable tariffs.

**Shared Motorbikes:** Electric scooters are a fun way to explore the city with over 6,000 vehicles.

### Private driver

**Taxis:** Comfortable and cheap, taxis rarely stop when hailed, you need to walk to the nearest taxi rank.

**Taxis Apps:** FreeNow, ItTaxi, WeTaxi and Apptaxi are just some of the apps available. Uber and Lyft operate in Italy but are less popular.

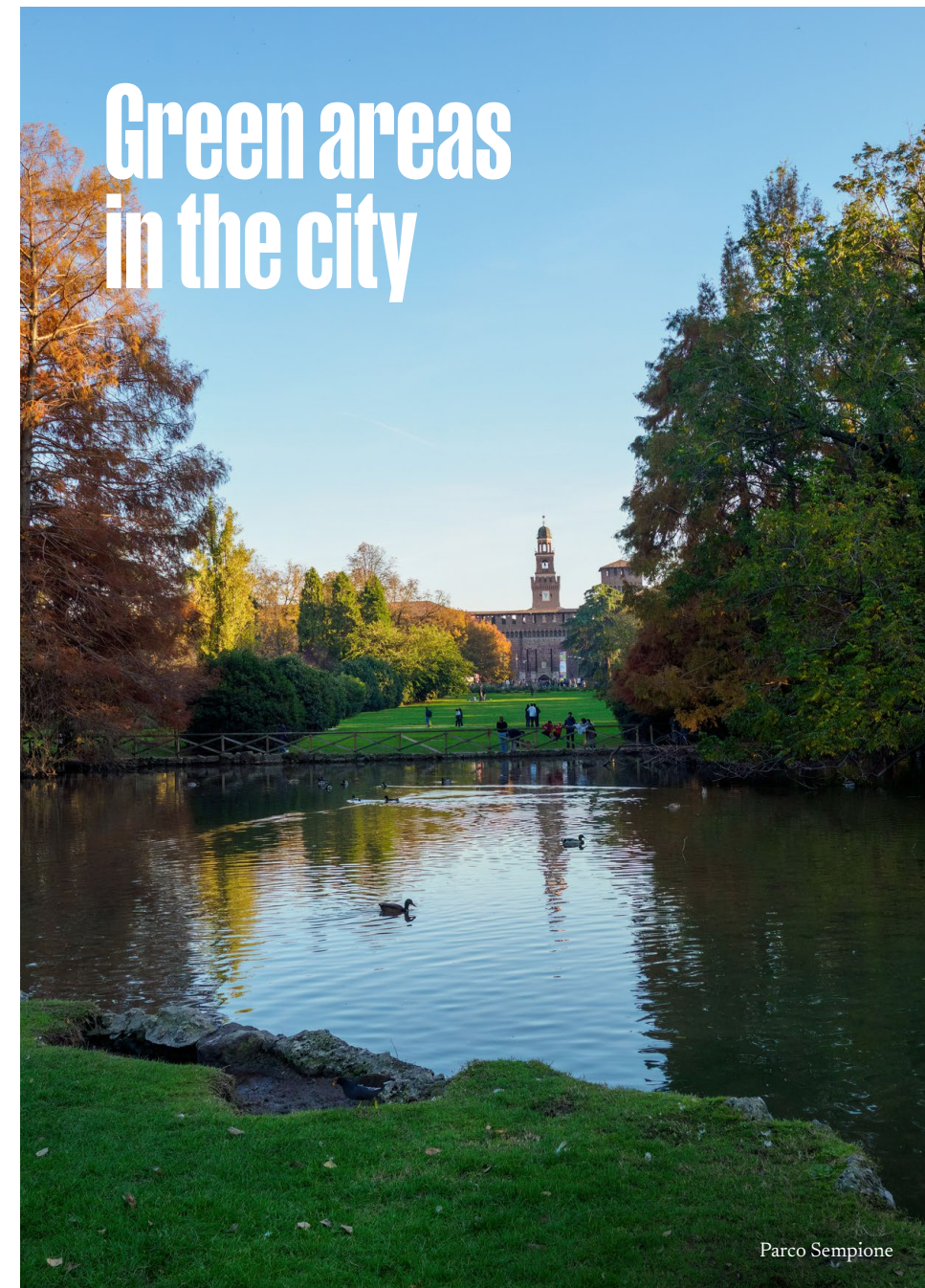
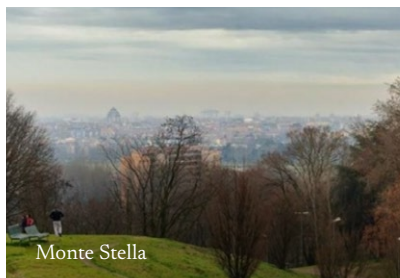
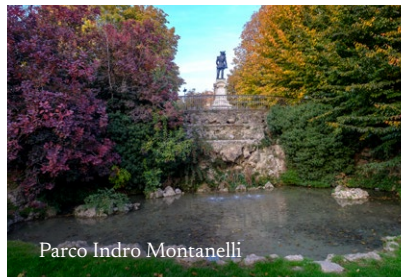
## Health

EU citizens can access medical care but we advise you to apply for a European Health Insurance Card.

112 is the emergency services (ambulance, fire and rescue) free-phone 24/7 across the EU and covers 80 languages.

Healthcare centres provide primary care while specialist services are available in hospitals. Medicines must be bought in pharmacies displaying the illuminated green cross. Antibiotics are sold on prescription only.

Milan boasts many beautiful parks and romantic gardens scattered amidst the cathedrals and office blocks. Parco Sempione is the green heart of the city and one of the most famous where visitors can go for long walks or a jog, as well as appreciate historic architecture like the Arco della Pace. There are refreshment kiosks offering tasty snacks throughout the day and the Bar Bianco has delicious food right next to the lake. Picnics sitting on the grass or a park bench, Milan has many hidden gems for a great day outdoors.

## Art & Culture

**Pinacoteca di Brera.** Opened in 1809 thanks to Napoleon, and features Italian masterpieces.

**Arco della Pace.** Standing in the geometric centre of Piazza Sempione the marble monument stands 25m tall.

**Pinacoteca Ambrosiana.** Built in 1618, the museum has 24 rooms with works from da Vinci, Caravaggio and Raphael.

**Duomo.** One of the best known structures in Italy, the 3rd largest in the world, the Duomo was built with white marble from Candoglia.

**Teatro alla Scala.** Commissioned by the Empress of Austria, La Scala dates from 1778, and is one of the world's oldest and most iconic theatres.

**Fondazione Prada.** Founded in 1993 with a wide network of collaborators: artists, curators, scientists, filmmakers, architects and musicians.

**Cimitero Monumentale.** Tombs, mausoleums and monuments reflect Milan's rich cultural past.

## Shopping

**Quadrilatero della Moda.** Dating back to the 19th century, Milan's world-famous fashion district oozes style and exclusivity extending across four main streets.

**Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II.** Italy's oldest active shopping gallery with its impressive dome is one of the largest in Europe with Armani, Versace, Prada, Valentino...

**La Rinascente - Piazza Duomo.** This flagship department store is a full-on experience of fashion, beauty, design and gourmet food, the essence of Italian style.

**Porta Nuova.** Milan's central business district is packed with shops, bookstores, bars and restaurants. It also features green spaces and pedestrianised walkways.

**Via Brera.** The main shopping street in the homonymous district with many boutiques, jewellers, art galleries and antique shops.

**Roof top bars.** nhow Milano, features a rooftop with the soul of a beach club where you can relax and enjoy yourself.

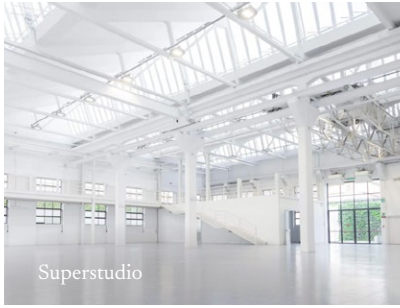
**NH Collection Milano CityLife,** offers an exclusive rooftop with an awe-inspiring shimmering pool and panoramic views.

**Ristorante Berton.** Chef Andrea Berton turns eating into an art form with live music and great vibe.

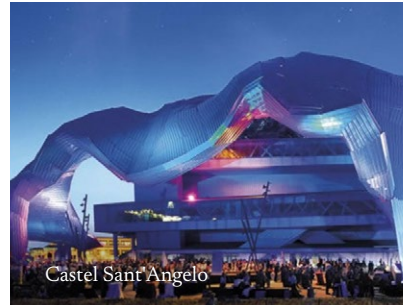

Formerly the Cristo Re church this unique building has been completely redesigned, maintaining some of the original features whilst complementing by new installations such as the stunning rooftop pool.

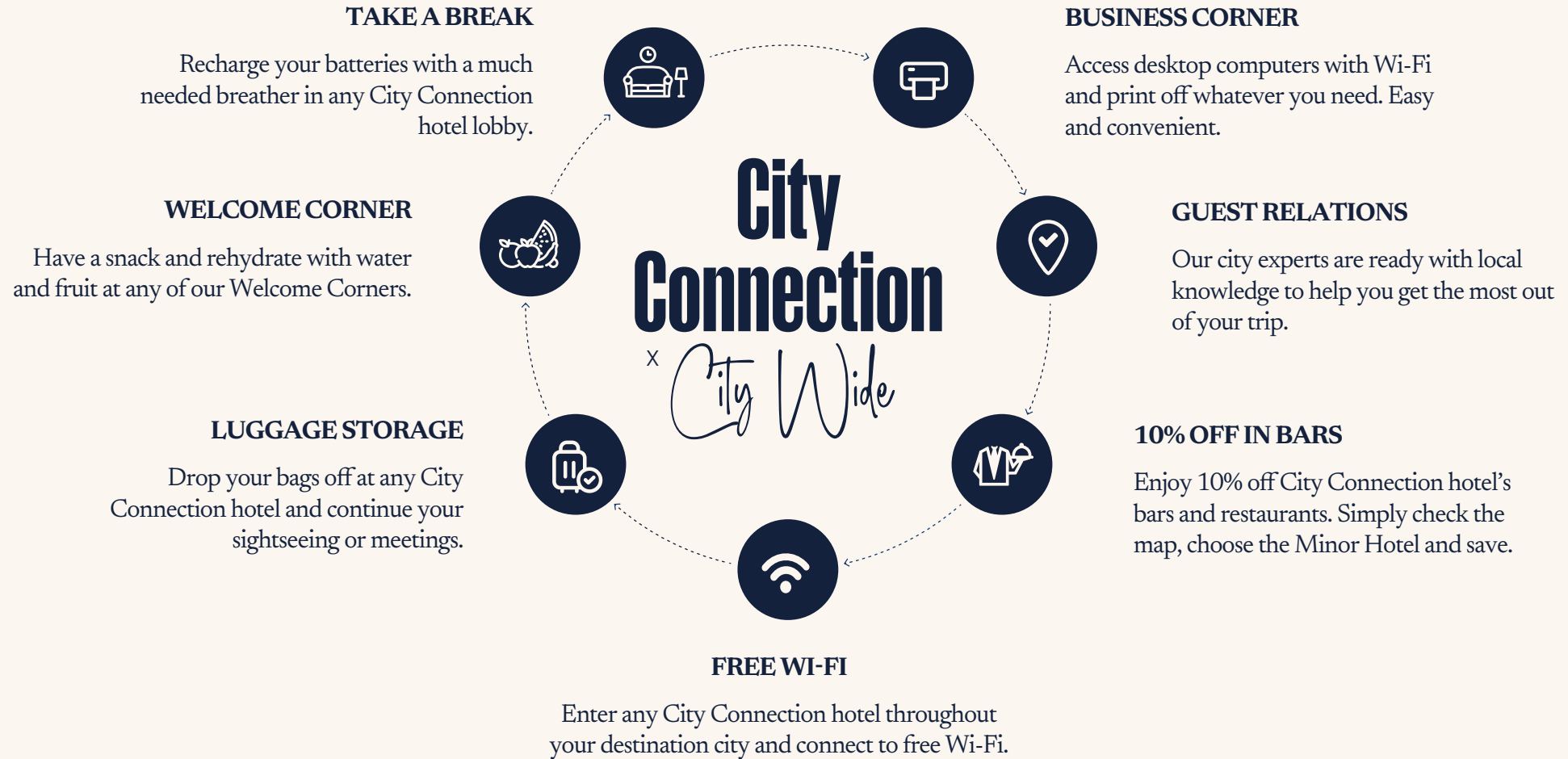

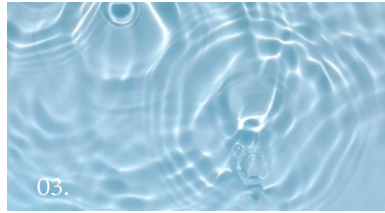
## Sustainable Certifications

Minor Europe & America's hotel portfolio is certified, both in environmental impact assessment of the construction and operation of its buildings, as well as in energy efficiency systems for accommodation, services, meetings and events. These include BREEAM, LEED, DGNB, ISO 14001, Green Key, Hoteles Más Verdes, Biosphere and Bioscore.



## Responsible Energy Management

We promote an efficient energy management system, defined under ISO 50001 criteria, and prioritise the use of green electricity from renewable sources in all our hotels. 85% of the company's electricity comes from renewable energy sources.



## Responsible Water Management

We have implemented water-saving measures such as installing reduction devices in cisterns and innovative water recovery systems. Additionally, we support employee training and awareness initiatives, as well as the redesign of the kitchen and housekeeping operational guidelines to further promote sustainability efforts.



## Reducing Single-Use Plastic

We strive to minimise the use of paper and single-use plastics, replacing them with reusable or biodegradable alternatives, when possible, to reduce waste. 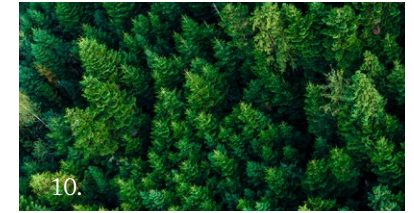
## Green Mobility
