Tips when visiting Rome

- Most stores in Rome are open Monday through Saturday, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm
- The standard voltage is 220v and the power plug is type F with 2 round pins.
- You can safely drink water from the street fountains, houses, hotels and restaurants.
- July is the hottest month in Rome with an average temperature of 26°C (78°F) and the coldest is January at 8°C (46°F) with the most daily sunshine hours at 11am in July. The wettest month is December with an average of 96mm of rain. The best month to swim in the sea is in August when the average sea temperature is 26°C (79°F).
- EU nationals can stay for up to 90 days for certain purposes. A valid passport or visa may be required at border control for some nationalities.

Mobility

Public transport

Bus: 338 daily bus lines, 22 night buses and 8,260 stops. Delays and long waits are common.

Metro: Rome has 3 metro lines that cross the city diagonally with stops near the top attractions.

Direct Bus Transfer: At Fiumicino Airport, exiting Terminal 3, on the right at bus stop number 12 where the shuttles for Rome Termini Station leave.

Train: 3 lines: Rome-Lido, Rome-Viterbo and Rome-Giardinetti, run every 10 to 20 minutes from 05:30 am to 10:30 pm (Rome-Lido until 11:30 pm)

Transport rental

Driving around: The motorini (anything on two wheels) own the road. Be aware and look out for pedestrians. Driving and parking can be a challenge to say the least.

Parking: The centre has active, limited traffic zones (ZTL) and you'll be fined if you enter. White lined parking is free, blue lined is paid at the metre.

Renting Bikes: Both electric and pedal powered bikes are available with dedicated lanes but with many cobbled streets Rome is not known as a bike friendly city.

Car Sharing: These apps are simple, sustainable and better value for money. With guaranteed parking and circulation in limited traffic zones.

Shared Motorbikes: Scooters and e-scooters are reserved through easy and ready-to-use apps.

Private driver

Taxis: The city has over 15,000 taxis available 24/7.

Private Transport with Driver: Apps like Uber, Cabify, and Bolt offer convenient ways to move around Rome.

Health

EU citizens can access medical care but we advise you to apply for a European Health Insurance Card.

112 is the emergency services (ambulance, fire and rescue) free-phone 24/7 across the EU and covers 80 languages.

Healthcare centres provide primary care while specialist services are available in hospitals. Medicines must be bought in pharmacies displaying the illuminated green cross. Antibiotics are sold on prescription only.

Rome has a rich history of city parks that don't cost a thing to enjoy them. The most famous is Rome's central park, Villa Borghese, with its leafy lanes, magnificent museums and bike rentals. The city is characterized by an important presence of green spaces, parks and gardens. Many of those are named after old aristocratic families, for example the Borghese and the Doria Pamphili, who were strongly connected to the Vatican. During the fifteenth and sixteenth centuries, these families lived in gorgeous villas, surrounded by stunning gardens and parks, located in the heart of the city.

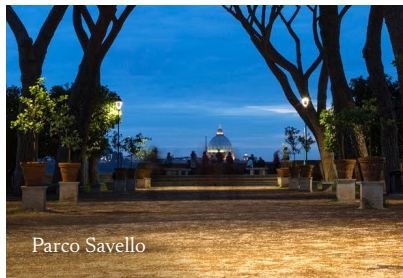

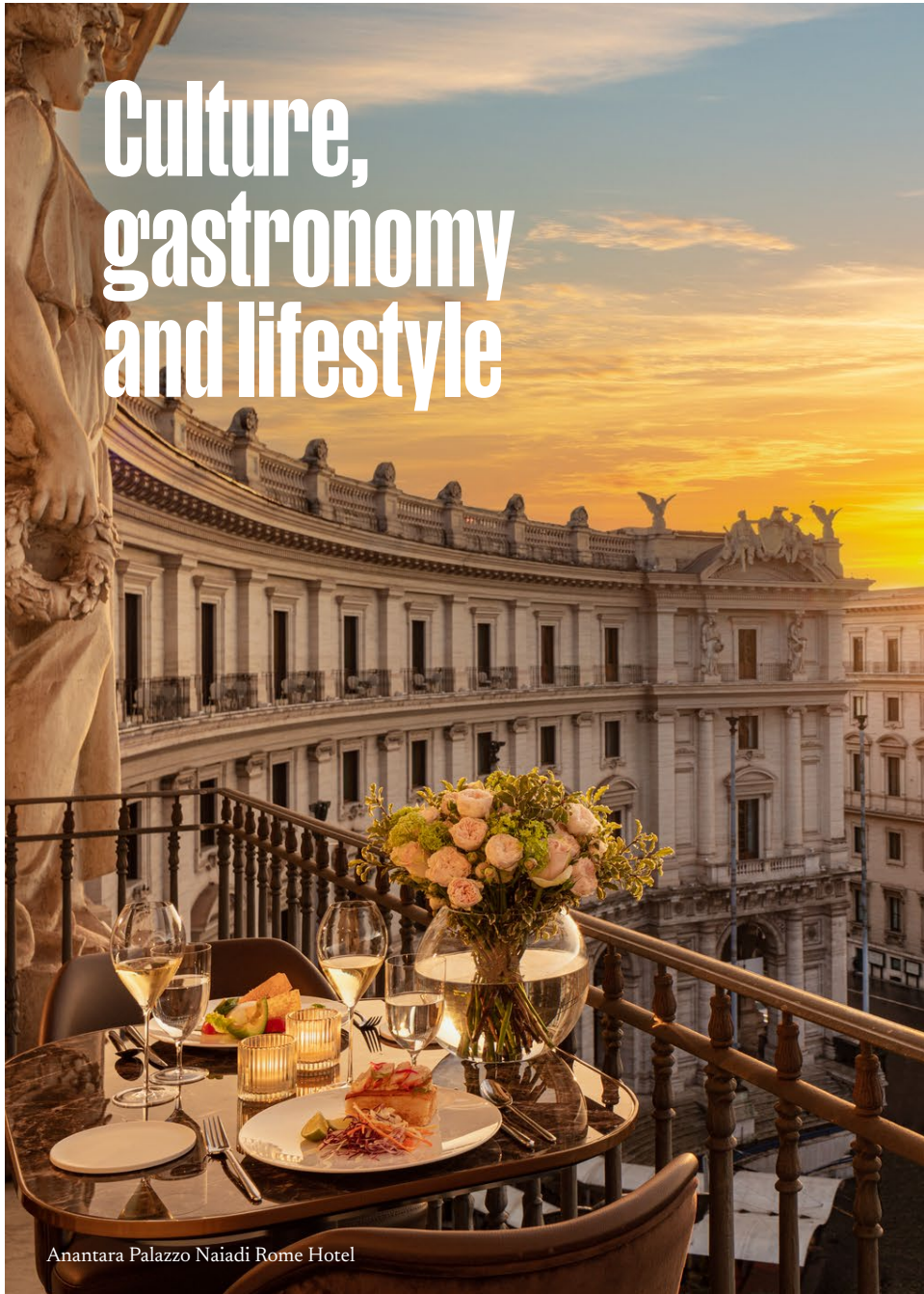

Art & Culture

Colosseum. One of the 7 Wonders, this breathtaking amphitheatre seated 80,000.

Roman Forum. Once the place of public meetings, law courts and gladiatorial combats, and was lined with shops and open-air markets.

Trevi Fountain. Throw 1 coin and return to Rome. 2 coins and fall in love. 3 coins and you'll get married.

St. Peter's Square. Designed by Bernini in the 17th century, it has 284 columns and 88 pilasters with 140 statues of saints.

Sistine Chapel. Located inside the Vatican Museum and decorated with frescoes by Michelangelo with the Last Judgement above the altar.

Pantheon. Representing the glory of Ancient Rome, The Pantheon was built to honour 12 pagan Greek Gods. It later served as inspiration to the great Renaissance architect Raphael.

Monti. Stroll the cobbled streets full of vintage shops and tiny fashion boutiques.

La Rinascente. Italy's iconic department store since 1865. A cultural hub with a rooftop restaurant for unbelievable views over the skyline.

Spanish Steps. From Piazza di Spagna, swanky shops like Bulgari, Max Mara and Zegna, attract you with fine leather goods.

Porta Portese. Sunday morning features the weekly Trastevere flea market with antique books, furniture, and handmade accessories where bargaining is expected.

Via dei Coronari. This street is lined with antique dealers, the place to go for colourful textiles, vintage prints or artisanal perfumes.

Via dell'Oca. Avant-garde jewellery, Cornucopia hip designer clothing, Patrizia Fabri hats, all renown local brands in the same street.

Campo dei Fiori. A walk around the "field of flowers" featuring Piazza Farnese with fountains and frescoes, where you can grab a cup of freshly squeezed pomegranate juice in the market.

Mercato Trionfale. Over 200 stalls in different colors, green is for fruit and veg, light-green is for homegrown, yellow is for bread, blue is for fish and butchers, not surprisingly, in red.

Great Pizza. Pizzarium at Via della Meloria 43 offers tender and chewy crust adorned with intensely flavored cheese and cured meats. Amaranto at Via Adige offers great pizza by-the-slice.

Aroma. Multisensory gastronomic experiences with views over the Colosseum.

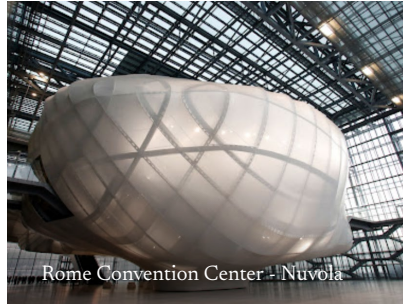

Fiera di Roma. Opened in 2006, it's the trade fair hub of Rome and one of the largest in Europe, features 9 pavilions, a conference centre, 10 fully equipped meeting rooms and over 390,000 m².

Palazzo Bonaparte. A 16th century palace overlooking Piazza Venezia, was home to Napoleon's mother, now features as Rome's newest premiere exhibition space.

Castel Sant'Angelo. Hadrian's Mausoleum found on the right bank of the Tiber is now a world-renowned museum, featuring preserved frescoes, sculptures and breathtaking views of Rome.

Villa Aurelia. Perfect for sophisticated events and celebrations, as it sits perched in a commanding position overlooking ancient Rome, with capacity for 200 guests inside and 300 outside.

Convention Centres

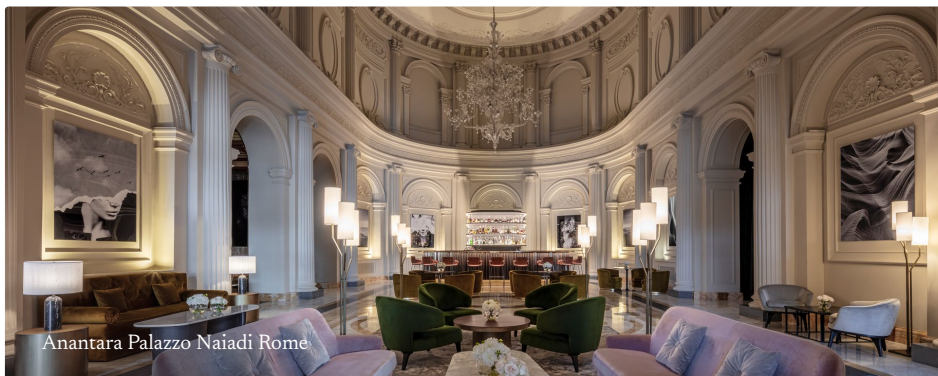

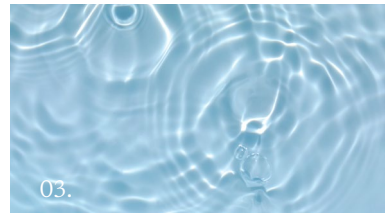
Sustainable Certifications

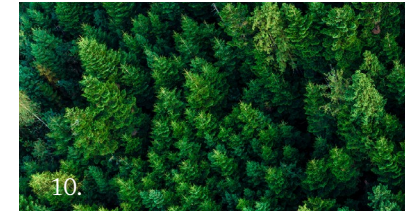
Green Mobility
