## Tips when visiting Vienna

- Most stores in Vienna are open Monday through Saturday, 10:00 am to 2:00 pm and from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm.
- The standard voltage is 220v and the power plug is type F with 2 round pins.
- Tap water in Vienna comes from the Alps and is perfectly safe to drink.
- Vienna has a typically dry continental climate, with warm summers and cold, snowy and windy winters. Late spring is the best time to visit with temperatures of min 9°C to max 20°C.
- EU nationals can stay for up to 90 days for certain purposes. A valid passport or visa may be required at border control for some nationalities.

## Mobility

### Public transport

**Bus:** Well developed public transport network with 127 bus lines, of which 24 are night lines running from 12:30 am – 5:00 am.

**Metro:** Wiener Linien operates 5 underground lines that can take you almost anywhere in the city.

**Airport Shuttle:** Buses from Vienna Airport leave every 30 mins and take 20 mins to reach the centre.

**Trains:** Vienna has U-Bahn (subway), S-Bahn (local trains) and Strassenbahn (trams), they are cheap, fast, frequent and rarely overcrowded.

### Transport rental

**Driving around:** Respect trams, be careful at bus stops, priority is to the right, and watch for cyclists on one-way streets.

**Parking:** Short-term and prepaid parking and garages are expensive. Park & ride facilities offer cheaper parking on the outskirts.

**Renting Bikes:** One of the most bike-friendly cities in EU, vast network of bike lanes and a great way to see the city.

**Car Sharing:** Many apps are available 24/7 and free-float.

**Shared Motorbikes:** Scooters and e-scooters are reserved through easy and ready-to-use apps.

### Private driver

**Taxis:** Quick, comfortable and can be hailed.

**Private Transport with Driver:** Uber, FreeNow, Bolt are competitively priced.

## Health

EU citizens can access medical care but we advise you apply for a European Health Insurance Card.

112 is the emergency services (ambulance, fire and rescue) free-phone 24/7 across the EU and covers 80 languages.

Healthcare centres provide primary care while specialist services are available in hospitals. Medicines must be bought in pharmacies displaying the illuminated green cross. Antibiotics are sold on prescription only.

Viennese parks, vineyards, forests and green spaces abound with spectacular flower gardens and tree-lined paths. One of the greenest cities in the world where over half of the capital is made up of parks and meadows.

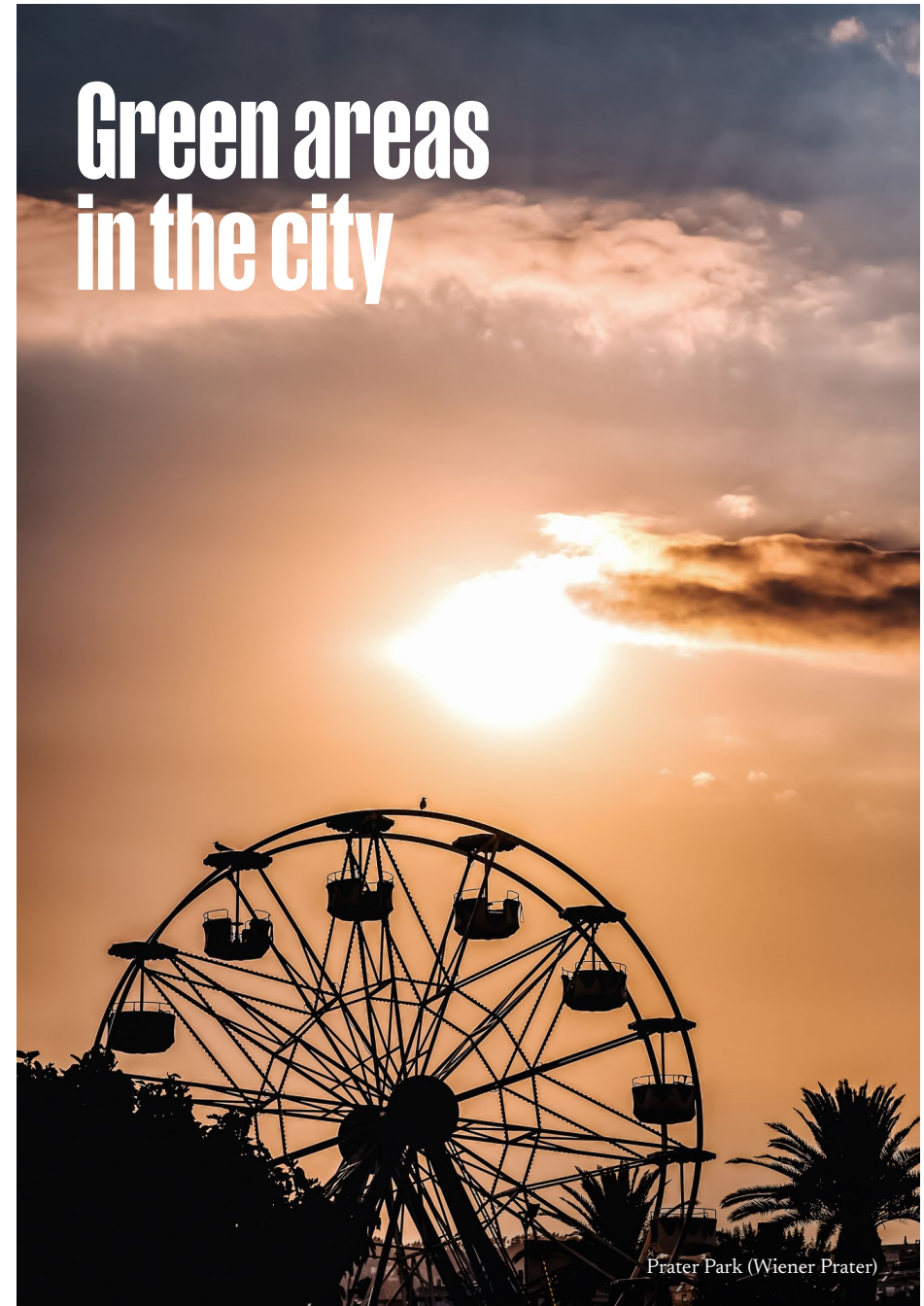

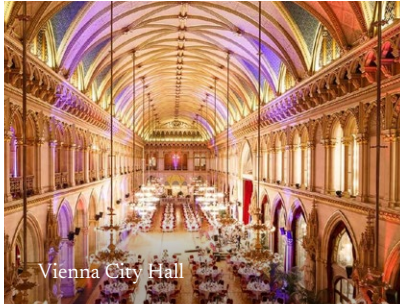
Coffee houses, wine taverns and markets, Vienna has an excellent variety of places and things to eat.

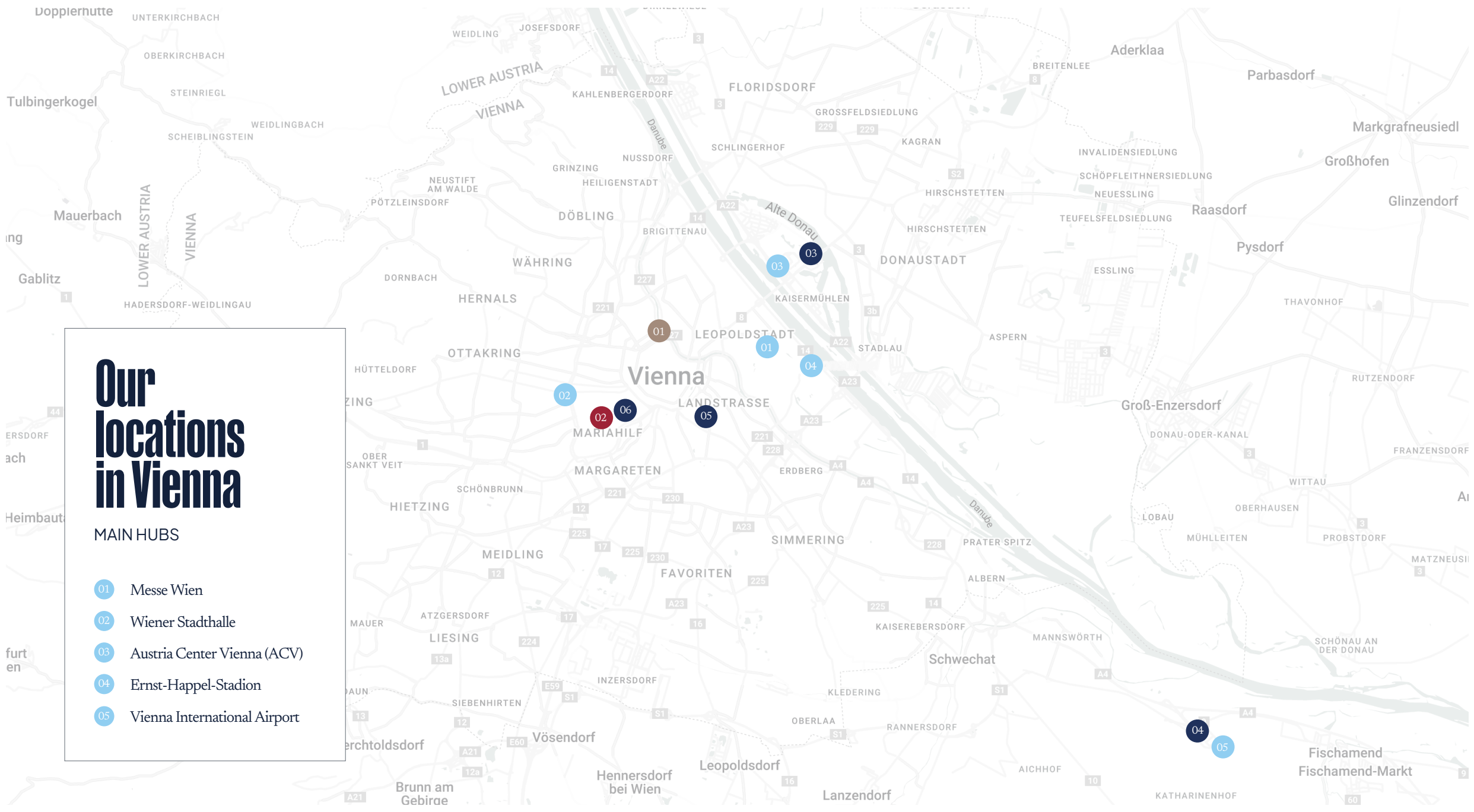

114 traditionally decorated rooms are carpeted and upper rooms feature views over Belvedere Park.





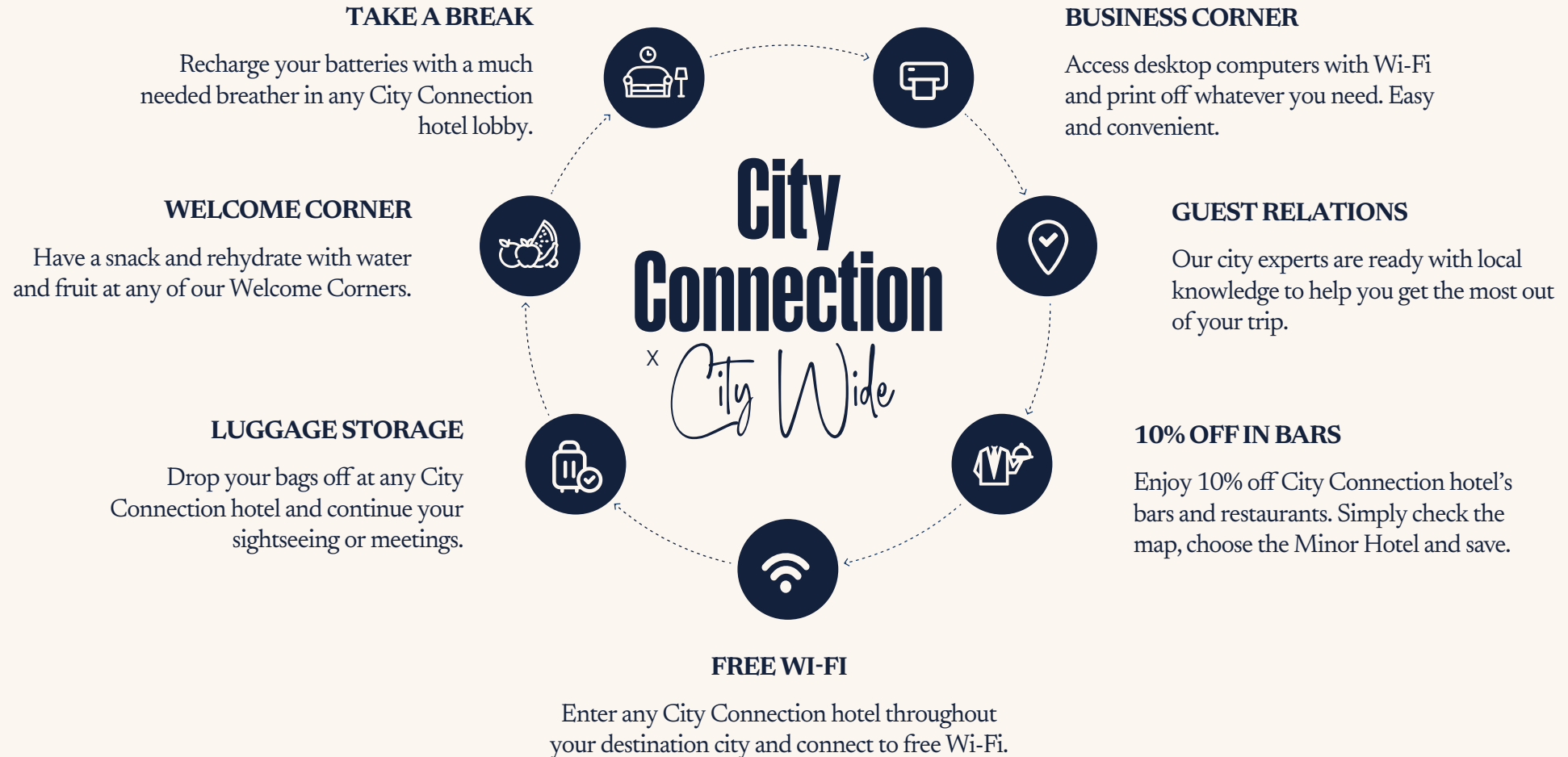
## NH Wien City

## Sustainable Certifications

Minor Europe & America's hotel portfolio is certified, both in environmental impact assessment of the construction and operation of its buildings, as well as in energy efficiency systems for accommodation, services, meetings and events. These include BREEAM, LEED, DGNB, ISO 14001, Green Key, Hoteles Más Verdes, Biosphere and Bioscore.



## Responsible Energy Management

We promote an efficient energy management system, defined under ISO 50001 criteria, and prioritise the use of green electricity from renewable sources in all our hotels. 85% of the company's electricity comes from renewable energy sources.



## Responsible Water Management

We have implemented water-saving measures such as installing reduction devices in cisterns and innovative water recovery systems. Additionally, we support employee training and awareness initiatives, as well as the redesign of the kitchen and housekeeping operational guidelines to further promote sustainability efforts.



## Reducing Single-Use Plastic

We strive to minimise the use of paper and single-use plastics, replacing them with reusable or biodegradable alternatives, when possible, to reduce waste. You'll find returnable glass bottles, biodegradable candy wrappers and pens, which are made from recycled material, in our meeting rooms. Our amenities are single-use plastic free and Eco-Label certified.



## Paperless Processes & Sustainable Forest Management

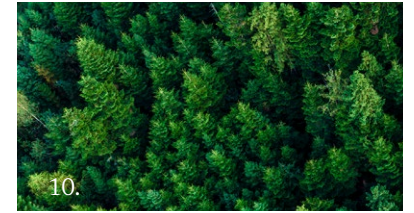
## Green Mobility
