

FISHING INFORMATION

OVERVIEW

Quirimbas National Park (QNP) is a protected area in the Cabo Delgado Province of Mozambique, encompassing the southern part of the Quirimbas Islands, as well as a significant mainland area. It is one of the most preserved and untouched ecosystems in Mozambique, a sanctuary for its extensive marine life offering excellent fishing opportunities. These waters are renowned for sailfish, marlin, dorado, wahoo, kingfish, queenfish, barracuda, mackerel, yellowfin and dogtooth tuna among others.

A catch and release practice within recreational fishing is highly recommended intended as a technique of conservation to ensure sustainability while preventing overharvest of fish stocks, often a fast measurement and weighing of the fish, followed by photography of the catch is worthwhile.

EQUIPMENT

Charters take place in our 8 metre fully rigged Cuddy Club 28 Butt Cat powered by 2 Suzuki DF150 Learn burn Precision controls and equipped with Lowrance SDS10 chart plotter, Garmin SV70 chirp 50kwa sounder, VHF Marine Radio and 5m outriggers.
