## Sky High

The newly opened Anantara Al Jabal Al Akhdar Resort in the Sultanate of Oman is a rare jewel. Perched 2,000 metres above sea level on the rim of a canyon, this five-star resort on the vast Saiq Plateau has 115 rooms, suites and villas, all with dramatic canyon views. Among the resort's six restaurants, the Dining by Design is, perhaps, likely to be the most memorable as it offers tailor-made dinner menus served on a canyon-edge platform called Diana's Point where Princess Diana once visited.
